Habitat and Diet

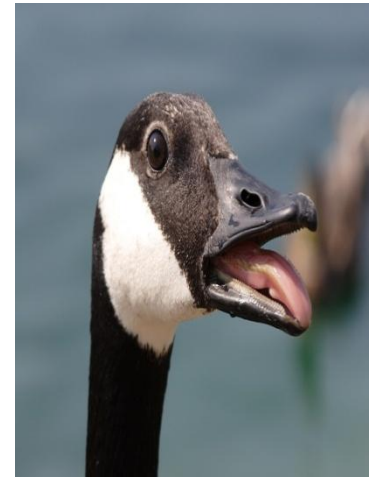
The geese will eat insects, fish eggs, fish, spiders, caterpillars, and food that people feed them.

Life Cycle

The life cycle of a goose is simple. First they hatch from their egg. Soon after the goslings are half grown, their parents shed their wing and tail feathers. Then the goslings are adults. Soon they fly south.



Interesting Facts

They have special vocal cords. If they hear a hissing goose they will make room for it. They also have no similar species. Some of the geese don't make it south! Also some lose their nest after flying south. They are a waterfowl.
