

Expectations for Incoming Kindergarten Students

Basic Skills:

- Tie shoes laces independently
- Put on coat and zip
- Button shirt, pants, all clothing independently
- Can blow nose when needed
- Wash hands with soap independently
- Can verbalize when the restroom is needed and can use facilities independently
- Can sit quietly to listening activities for a minimum of 20 minutes
- Will follow simple directions
- Knows phone number and parent(s) names

Language Arts:

- Name all 26 letters of the alphabet, lower and upper case in random order
- Gives the sound associated with the 21 consonant letters
- Writes first name legible with capital as the first letter
- Writes using proper three finger pencil grip
- Names eight basic colors
- Says the days of the week

Mathematics:

- Counts orally from 0 to 25
 - Counts backwards from 25 to 0
 - Writes numerals from 0 to 10
 - Demonstrates understanding of number concepts 1 to 10
 - Identifies the 4 basic shapes: triangle, square, circle, and rectangle
